## NOTICE OF WATER RIGHT APPLICATION

LAS 28393

Pursuant to AS 46.15 and rules and regulations promulgated there under, public notice is hereby given that an application has been received from the Copper Valley Electric Association, P.O. Box 45, Glenallen, Alaska 99588 to appropriate water as follows:

Up to 80 cubic feet per second from Allison Creek located approximately 5 miles south of Valdez, located within Sections 19 and 20, Township 9 South, Range 6 West, Copper River Meridian for a hydroelectric dam. Water used to generate electricity will be returned to the creek at the powerhouse at the base of the Allison Creek. All water in excess of 80 cubic feet per second will be returned to Allison Creek at the spillway. The holder of this permit must adhere to all conditions in FERC license P-13124.

The public is invited to comment on these actions. Any facts tending to show that the rights of the objector or the public interest would be adversely affected by the proposed water appropriation must be submitted in writing to the Water Resources Section by 5:00 p.m. June 8, 2016, at the above address to be considered. Comments that might assist the Water Resources Section in its determination of the public interest pursuant to AS 46.15.080 are also requested and must be received in writing by the above deadline. In order to establish appeal rights regarding this decision, you are required by law to meaningfully participate in the decision process by commenting on the decision, in writing, prior to the comment deadline. If issued, permits may be extended for good cause shown, pursuant to AS 46.15.110 and 11 AAC 93.120(f), without additional public notice.
