Please accept this letter on behalf of C.P. Crane LLC (“Crane”) as its withdrawal of its application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) that was docketed as Case No. 9421. For reasons not anticipated at the time of filing of the application, Crane no longer expects to proceed with the project for which a CPCN was sought.
