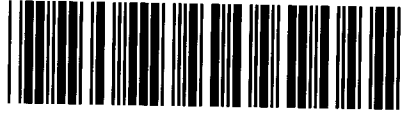

**JOINT PARTIES' PROPOSED ALLOTMENT OF TIME AND
PANEL COMPOSITION IN RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 15**

TO THE HONORABLE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION OF TEXAS:

COME NOW, Electric Reliability Council of Texas, Inc. (ERCOT), Calpine Corporation (Calpine), NRG Energy Inc. (NRG), Texas Industrial Energy Consumers (TIEC), CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC (CenterPoint Energy), Cross Texas Transmission LLC (CTT), Luminant Generation Company LLC and Luminant Energy Company LLC (Luminant), City of Garland (Garland), and Commission Staff (collectively, Joint Parties), and pursuant to Order No. 15 file their proposed allotment of time for opening statements, cross examinations, and re-direct examinations at the Hearing on the Merits on October 17, 2014.

Allotment of Time¹

Commission Staff has requested a total time of 15 minutes at the Hearing on the Merits. After Commission Staff's allocated time, the Parties have proposed a percentage allocation of time as reflected in the below table.

¹ A Party may allocate any portion of its time to another Party.

Parties	Proposed Allotment of Time
Calpine/NRG	42%
ERCOT	30%
Intervenors (TIEC, CenterPoint Energy, CTT, Luminant, and Garland)	28%
TOTAL	100%

Further, the Joint Parties have agreed to three panel compositions for cross-examination and redirect and Commission questioning at the Hearing on the Merits as follows:


Cross-Examination and Redirect Panels

Panel Composition	Parties
First Panel	Calpine/NRG Witnesses (Profs. Baughman and Baldick)
Second Panel	Intervenors Witnesses (Mr. Griffey, Mr. Kemper, and Mr. Cook)
Third Panel	ERCOT Witnesses (Mr. Pfeifenberger, Mr. Lasher, and Mr. Billo)

Finally, the Parties have agreed to file post-hearing briefs in lieu of closing arguments at the Hearing on the Merits. The Parties propose that the briefs be due on Friday, October 31, 2014, with a 25-page limitation for arguments. As such, the Parties request that the ALJ take this recommendation into consideration at the prehearing conference on October 15, 2014 in order to allow for the most efficient presentation of each Party's case at the Hearing on the Merits.

By agreement and permission of the Joint Parties, ERCOT is filing the Joint Parties' Response to Order No. 15 on the Joint Parties' behalf.
