Dear Clerk Mount:

This filing is to notify the Commission of Duke Energy Renewables NC Solar, LLC's (DER NC Solar) intent to assign its rights to own and develop the 80 MW_{AC} facility certificated in the above referenced project. As stated in its application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN), DER NC Solar was in negotiations with SunEnergy 1, LLC (SunEnergy1) to develop, design and construct the facility. SunEnergy1 is an affiliate of Wildwood Solar, LLC, the holder of a CPCN for a 40 MW_{AC} facility located adjacent to the facility proposed in this docket. DER NC Solar has decided to assign its developmental rights to SunEnergy1 rather than to own the facility. The agreement between SunEnergy1 and DER NC Solar for the assignment of the development rights to the 80 MW_{AC} facility is contingent on favorable action by this Commission on SunEnergy1's motion filed in Docket No. SP-5310, Sub 0.
