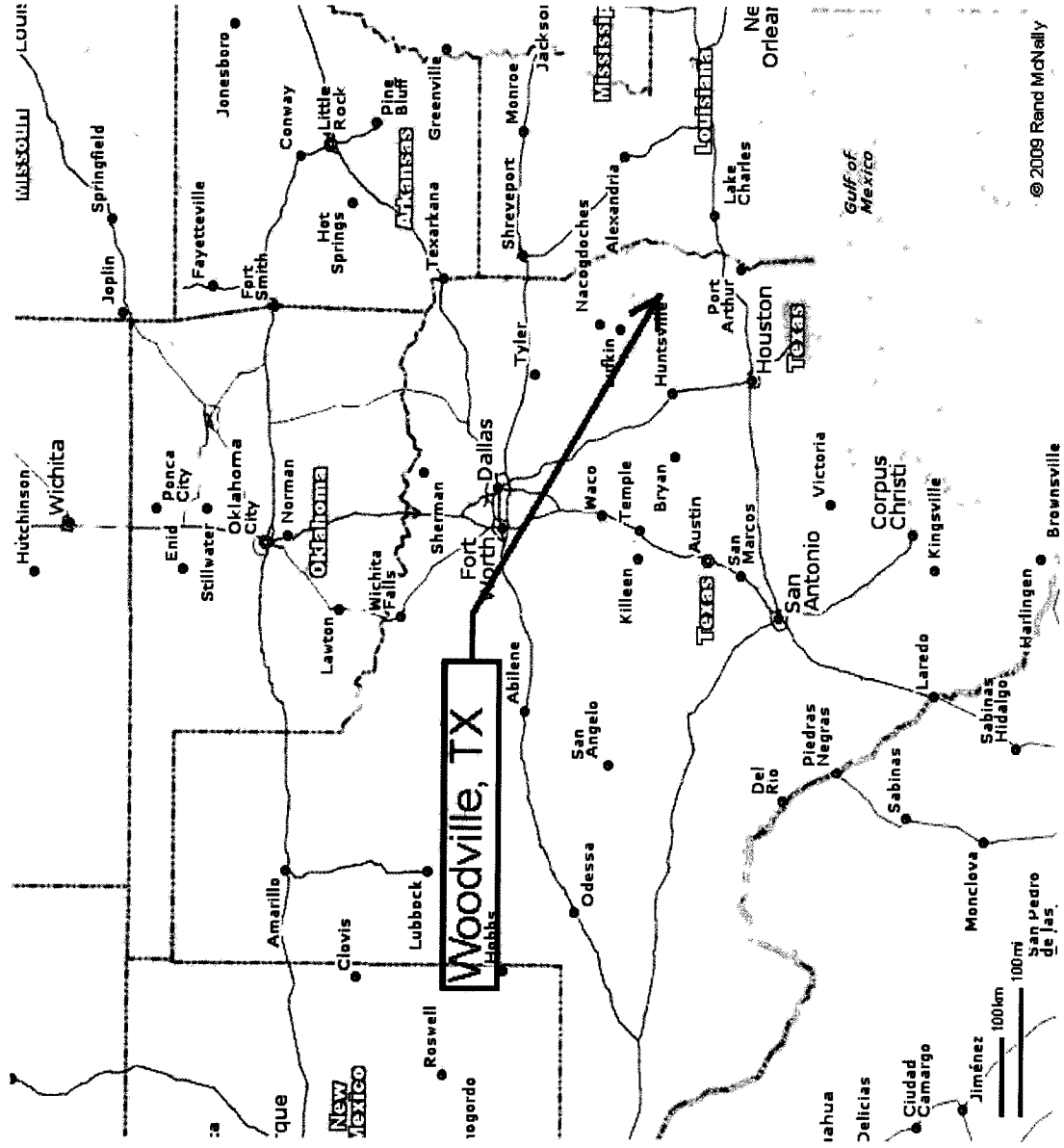

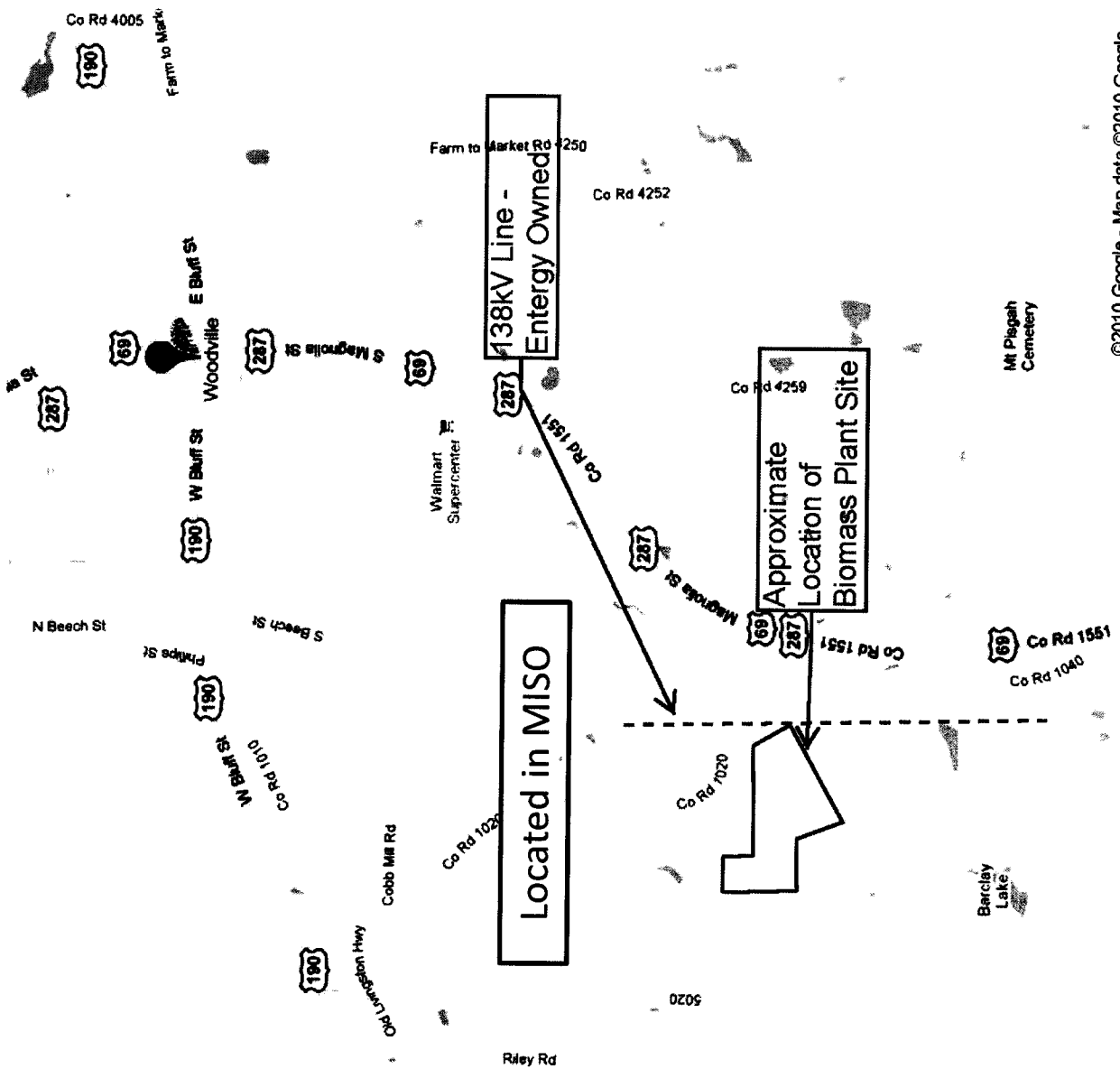

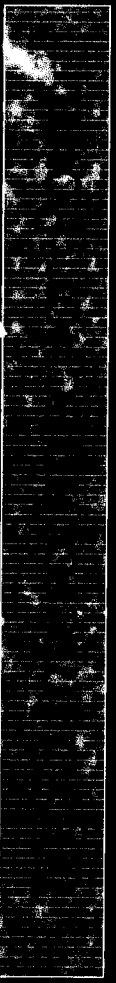
Project Location - Woodville, TX – Tyler County

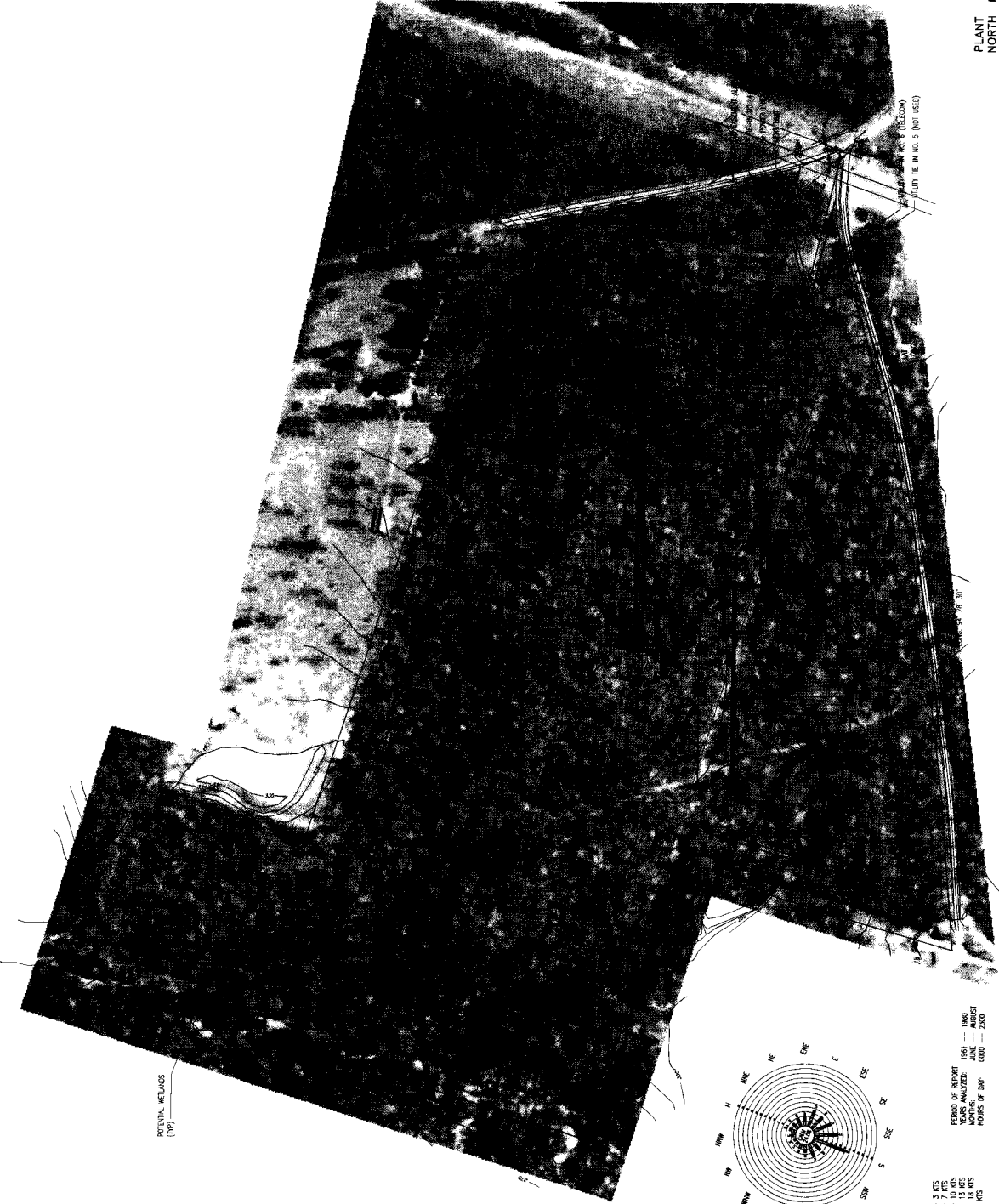


Woodville Renewable Power Project Site Location
