In the Matter of the Application of Exelon Wind, LLC for a Certificate to Site Wind-Powered Electric Generation Facilities in Seneca County, Ohio

Dear Mr. Donlon and Ms. McNeal:

This letter serves as the pre-application notification letter to the Ohio Power Siting Board of Exelon Wind, LLC (“Applicant” or “Exelon”) a wholly owned subsidiary of Exelon Generation Company, LLC which in turn is an affiliate of Exelon Corporation, a Fortune 500 company application for its proposed wind farm, which will result in a total generating capacity of up to 200 megawatts (“MW”). A motion for certain waiver requests has been filed, with the certificate application being filed in the next several months.

In accordance with Ohio Administrative Code (“OAC”) Rule 4906-3-03(A), Applicant provides the following information:

- **Project Description.** The proposed wind farm is located in Seneca County (“Seneca Farm”) and will consist of approximately 87 turbines each with a capacity of between 2.3 and 2.5 MW that will generate up to 200 MW. The wind farm will have associated infrastructure (i.e. access roads, electrical collection system, a transmission line within the project area, construction staging area, operations and maintenance facilities and substations). The wind turbine array will be spread across approximately 25,000 acres of leased land located in portions of Sciopo, Reed, Eden, Bloom and Venice Townships in Seneca County, Ohio.
- **Pre-Application Public Informational Meeting.** The Applicant plans to hold a public information meeting in the next several months. Applicant will update this pre-application letter with this information at least fifteen (15) days prior to the public information meeting as required by OAC Rule 4906-3-03(A)(2).

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- **Anticipated Waivers.** Pursuant to OAC Rules 4906-3-03 and 4906-7-12(C), the Applicant will be asking the Board to grant certain waivers from the Board's filing requirements for wind farms. Applicant's waiver request is being filed in conjunction with this letter, and seeks the following waivers:
 - (1) From providing map of vegetative cover as set forth OAC Rule 4906-17-05(A)(3)(g), and instead allow the Applicant to provide a general narrative description of the vegetative cover that may be disturbed during construction.
 - (2) From certain requirements relating to cross-sectional views and test borings and map set forth in OAC Rule 4906-17-05(A)(4), and instead allow the Applicant to submit representative information once it determines the final location of turbines and other structures.
