Reference: Large Generator Interconnection Agreement

Dear Mr. Williams:

On November 9, 2016, Arizona Public Service Company (APS) filed a non-conforming Large Generator Interconnection Agreement (LGIA) between APS's transmission and generation divisions, designated as Service Agreement No. 356 under APS's Open Access Transmission Tariff. The LGIA is accepted for filing, effective October 10, 2016, as requested, subject to the outcome of Docket No. ER16-2656-000.¹

This filing was noticed on November 9, 2016, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before November 30, 2016. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made

by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against APS.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
