Dear Ms. Friedman:

On September 17, 2012, you filed on behalf of the ArcLight Companies a notice of change in status stating that Southeast PowerGen, LLC acquired Mid-Georgia Cogen L.P. (Mid-Georgia Cogen), which owns a 323 megawatt generation facility in Georgia, in the Southern Company balancing authority area. You state that the ArcLight Companies are now all affiliated with Mid-Georgia Cogen. You further state that all of the output from the Mid-Georgia Cogen facility is fully committed to a third party under a long-term sales contract. You represent that this new affiliation does not affect the conditions the Commission relied upon when granting the ArcLight Companies market-based rate authority.

Your filing was noticed on September 18, 2012, with comments, protests or interventions due on or before October 9, 2012. None was filed.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, and based on your representations, the notice of change in status is accepted for filing.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against any of the applicant(s).

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
