ORDER CANCELLING PRELIMINARY PERMIT

(January 8, 2014)

On September 28, 2012, Yegua Mesa Hydro, LLC (permittee) was issued a preliminary permit to study the feasibility of the Yegua Mesa Pumped Storage Hydroelectric Project No. 13315,¹ to be located in San Miguel County, New Mexico. Article 4 of the preliminary permit requires that the permittee submit a progress report at the close of each six-month period from the effective date of the permit.

On October 21, 2013, the permittee was notified that its first progress report was overdue and therefore, that the permit would likely be cancelled in no less than 30 days. The permittee did not file a response; therefore, the preliminary permit is hereby cancelled.

The Director orders:

(A) The preliminary permit for the Yegua Mesa Pumped Storage Hydroelectric Project No. 13315 is cancelled effective the close of business on February 7, 2014. But, if the Commission is closed on this day, then the permit is cancelled effective the close of business on the next day in which the Commission is open, 18 C.F.R. § 385.2007(a)(2) (2013). No applications for this site may be submitted until after the cancellation is effective.

(B) This order constitutes final agency action. Any party may file a request for rehearing of this order within 30 days from the date of its issuance, as provided in section 313(a) of the FPA, 16 U.S.C. § 8251 (2012), and section 385.713 of the Commission's regulations, 18 C.F.R. § 385.713 (2013).
