Dear Mr. Dorsett:

On May 15, 2013, you submitted on behalf of Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc. (MISO) a generator interconnection agreement between Tuscola Wind II, LLC, International Transmission Company, and MISO.¹ Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation-Central, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal is accepted for filing, effective May 16, 2013, as requested, subject to the outcome of the ongoing proceedings in Docket Nos. ER12-309 and ER13-868.

Notice of the filing was issued on May 15, 2013, with protests and interventions due on or before June 5, 2013. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.214. No protests were filed.
