Dear Mr. Newlander:

On October 17, 2013, San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) filed a Certificate of Concurrence to the Large Generator Interconnection Agreement (Agreement) among California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO), SDG&E and Mesquite Solar 1, LLC (Mesquite) filed by CAISO in Docket No. ER13-2489-000 on September 30, 2013. Waiver of the Commission's notice requirements pursuant to section 35.11 of the Commission's rules and regulations (18 C.F.R § 35.11) is granted,¹ and the Certificate of Concurrence is accepted for filing, effective January 1, 2014, as requested.

The filing was noticed on October 17, 2013, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before November 7, 2013. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are

granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification or any rule, regulation or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your tariff; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against San Diego Gas & Electric Company.

This action is taken pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
