Dear Mr. Harnish:

On September 2, 2016, Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc. (MISO) submitted Service Agreement No. 2946 for Project J498 between MidAmerican Energy Company, as both interconnection customer and transmission owner, and MISO. The tariff record is accepted effective September 2, 2016, as requested.¹

The filing was noticed on September 2, 2016. Interventions and protests were due in all of the filings on or before September 23, 2016. None was filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification,

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - Central, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
