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**Re: Fauquier Landfill Gas, LLC, Docket No. ER16-____-000
Potomac Power Resources, LLC, Docket No. ER16-____-000
Notice of Cancellation of Market-Based Rate Tariffs**

Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to Section 35.15(a) of the regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (the Commission or FERC),¹ Fauquier Landfill Gas, LLC and Potomac Power Resources, LLC (collectively, the PES Entities) hereby submit for filing a Notice of Cancellation of their market-based rate tariffs. The market-based rate tariffs were originally accepted by the Commission in Docket Nos. ER04-472-000 and ER01-202-000, respectively, and are currently on file in Docket Nos. ER14-2636-000 and ER14-2634-000. The PES Entities respectfully request that the Commission waive its prior notice requirements and issue an order accepting this Notice of Cancellation effective as of April 21, 2016 (*i.e.*, one day after filing).

II. Background

Fauquier Landfill Gas, LLC (Fauquier Landfill) is a Delaware limited liability company. Fauquier Landfill owned an approximately two MW landfill gas-fired facility located at the Fauquier County Landfill in Fauquier County, Virginia. The facility was interconnected with the transmission system of Virginia Electric and Power Company. However, the Fauquier Landfill facility was retired effective January 31, 2016 and Fauquier Landfill has no customers.

Potomac Power Resources, LLC (PPR) is a Delaware limited liability company. PPR formerly owned four generating units in the PJM balancing authority area but all four retired in May and June of 2012. PPR has no customers.

III. Effective Date and Waiver

Fauquier Landfill and PPR received Commission authority to engage in wholesale sales of energy and capacity at market-based rates in the following effective FERC Dockets:

As explained above, due to retirements, the PES Entities' facilities are no longer in service, and the PES Entities do not intend to make sales of energy, capacity, or ancillary services at wholesale in the future. The PES Entities do not have any active customers taking service pursuant to wholesale power contracts under their MBR Tariffs. Therefore, no customers will be adversely affected by the cancellation. Additionally, as the MBR Tariffs are the only tariffs the PES Entities have on file, the PES Entities request that the Commission cancel their respective Tariff IDs concurrent with the effective date of the cancellation of the MBR Tariffs.

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The PES Entities respectfully request waiver of the sixty-day notice requirement under Section 35.15(a) of the Commission's regulations² in order to permit the cancellation to be effective as requested. Good cause for such waiver exists because the Commission generally finds a waiver of notice requirements "appropriate when an uncontested filing has no rate impact."³ The PES Entities' facilities have been retired and no customers will be adversely affected by the cancellation. Further, good cause exists because it will reduce the reporting obligations for the PES Entities without adversely impacting any other parties. Therefore, the PES Entities respectfully request the Commission waive the sixty-day notice requirement and accept this Notice of Cancellation effective April 21, 2016.

IV. Conclusion

For the reasons set forth herein, the PES Entities respectfully request that the Commission accept this Notice of Cancellation and cancel their MBR Tariffs and Tariff IDs effective April 21, 2016, one day after filing. Please contact the undersigned if you have any questions regarding this filing.
