Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to Section 385.1907 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("Commission") rules and regulations and the Commission's December 5, 2013 order¹ in the above-referenced proceeding, ISO New England Inc. (the "ISO") and Bangor Hydro Electric Company ("Bangor Hydro") (together, the "Filing Parties") submit this compliance filing.

On October 9, 2013, the Filing Parties filed an unexecuted Amended and Restated Standard Large Generator Interconnection Agreement by and among (i) the ISO as the System Operator; (ii) BHE as the Interconnecting Transmission Owner; (iii) Evergreen Wind Power II, LLC ("Evergreen Wind"), a First Wind subsidiary, as the Interconnection Customer; and (iv) Maine Gen Lead, LLC, also a First Wind subsidiary, as the Gen Lead Owner owning some of the Interconnection Facilities (the "Revised LGIA"). The December 5 Order accepted the Revised LGIA for filing, effective October 11, 2013, subject to Bangor Hydro submitting a compliance filing describing the outcome of the proceeding at the Maine Public Utilities Commission ("MPUC") concerning approval for the Revised LGIA.²

On November 11, 2013, the MPUC granted Bangor Hydro's request for approval of amendments to the LGIA relating to Evergreen Wind's Oakfield Wind Project. The Parties have now executed the Revised LGIA. Included herein is a fully executed, public version (with

critical energy infrastructure information (“CEII” redacted³) in eTariff format. The Revised LGIA is otherwise identical to the version included in the October 9, 2013 filing accepted by the December 5 Order.

The Filing Parties respectfully request that the Commission accept the executed Revised LGIA for filing, in compliance with the December 5 Order.
