BY THE COMMISSION: On June 17, 2015, in Docket No. SP-5310, Sub 0, the Commission issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN), pursuant

to G.S. 62-110.1(a) to Wildwood Solar, LLC (Wildwood), for construction of a 40-MW solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located at 1374 Caratoke Highway, Moyock, Currituck County, North Carolina.

On July 21, 2015, in Docket No. SP-5448, Sub 0, the Commission issued a CPCN pursuant to G.S. 62-110.1(a) to Duke Energy Renewables NC Solar, LLC (Duke Solar) for construction of an 80-MW solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located at 1384-1390 Caratoke Highway, Moyock, Currituck County, North Carolina.

On July 27, 2016, Wildwood filed an application with the Commission in Docket Nos. SP-5548, Sub 0 and SP-5310, Sub 1 requesting that the Commission transfer the Duke Solar CPCN to Wildwood.

On August 3, 2016, Duke Solar filed a verified statement in Docket Nos. SP-5548, Sub 0 and SP-5310, Sub 1 confirming the transfer of the Duke Solar CPCN to Wildwood.

On August 3, 2016, Wildwood filed an application in Docket Nos. SP-5548, Sub 0, SP-5310, Subs 0 and 1, SP-8243, Sub 0 and SP-8244, Sub 0, requesting that the Commission amend the Duke Solar and Wildwood CPCNs to authorize Wildwood to construct a 60-MW solar facility on the parcel of land previously identified for use by Duke Solar for an 80-MW facility, and to authorize Wildwood to construct a 60-MW facility on the parcel of land previously identified for use by Wildwood for a 40-MW facility. The application further described a minor adjustment to the common boundary line between the two parcels of land and explained that a substation and ancillary facilities will also be constructed on the sites. In addition, the application requested that the Wildwood CPCN be transferred to Summit Farms Solar, LLC (Summit) and that the Duke Solar CPCN be transferred to Ranchland Solar, LLC, (Ranchland). The application noted that both Summit and Ranchland are affiliates of SunEnergy1, LLC.

On August 8, 2016, Summit and Ranchland filed verified statements confirming that they have agreed to receive the transfers of the CPCNs requested by Wildwood in its August 3, 2016 filing and that they will abide by the Commission rules and regulations governing the CPCNs.

Based upon the foregoing and the record in these dockets, the Commission finds good cause to transfer the Duke Solar CPCN to Ranchland, and to amend the Duke Solar CPCN to authorize Ranchland to construct a 60-MW solar facility on the parcel of land previously identified for use by Duke Solar for an 80-MW facility. Further, the Commission finds good cause to transfer the Wildwood CPCN to Summit, and to amend the Wildwood CPCN to authorize Summit to construct a 60-MW facility on the parcel of land previously identified for use by Wildwood for a 40-MW facility. In addition, the Commission finds good cause to cancel the CPCNs previously issued to Duke Solar and Wildwood, and to close Docket Nos. SP-5448, Sub 0, and SP-5310, Subs 0 and 1.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That the application filed by Duke Energy Renewables NC Solar, LLC and Wildwood Solar, LLC, to transfer the CPCN issued to Duke Solar for construction of an 80-MW solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to Ranchland Solar, LLC, and to amend the CPCN to authorize Ranchland Solar, LLC, to construct a 60-MW solar facility on the parcel of land previously identified for use by Duke Solar for an 80-MW facility, is hereby approved.

2. That the application filed by Wildwood Solar, LLC, to transfer the CPCN issued to Wildwood for construction of a 40-MW solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to Summit Farms Solar, LLC, and to amend the CPCN to authorize Summit Farms Solar, LLC, to construct a 60-MW solar facility on the parcel of land previously identified for use by Wildwood for a 40-MW facility, is hereby approved.

3. That Appendices A and B attached to this Order shall constitute the new certificates of public convenience and necessity reflecting the transfers to Summit Farms Solar, LLC, and Ranchland Solar, LLC, respectively, and the amendments authorizing each entity to construct a 60-MW solar facility, along with a substation and other ancillary facilities to serve both electric generating facilities.

4. That the CPCN issued to Duke Energy Renewables NC Solar, LLC, in Docket No. SP-5448, Sub 0 for construction of an 80-MW solar facility is hereby cancelled.


5. That the CPCN issued to Wildwood Solar, LLC, in Docket No. SP-5310, Sub 0 for construction of a 40-MW solar facility is hereby cancelled.

6. That the Chief Clerk shall close Docket Nos. SP-5448, Sub 0, and SP-5310, Subs 0 and 1.




