BY THE CHAIRMAN: On February 25, 2015, in Docket No. SP-3209, Sub 0, the Commission issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) to Kelford Solar, LLC (Kelford) for construction of a 23.1-MW solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located on NC Highway 308, between the north and south intersections of Cherry Farm Road, in Kelford, Bertie County, North Carolina.

On March 18, 2015, in Docket Nos. SP-3209, Sub 0 and SP-4305, Sub 3, at the request of Kelford and Colonial Eagle Solar, LLC the Commission issued an Order transferring the CPCN from Kelford to Colonial Eagle Solar, LLC (Colonial Eagle).

On May 4, 2016, Colonial Eagle filed a request to update the CPCN and registration to reflect a reduction in the capacity of the facility from 23.1 MW to 21.5 MW.


Based on the foregoing and the record, the Chairman finds good cause to amend the CPCN and registration to state the capacity of the facility as 21.5 MW, and to issue the attached amended CPCN reflecting that change in capacity.


