BY THE CHAIRMAN: On August 6, 2014, the Commission issued an Order in the above-captioned docket granting Innovative Solar 33, LLC (Applicant), a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN), pursuant to G.S. 62-110.1(a) for construction of a 35-MW solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located Cleveland County, North Carolina, and accepted registration of the facility as a new renewable energy facility.

On October 5, 2016, the Applicant filed a statement requesting that the Applicant be allowed to withdraw the application for a CPCN and registration, and requesting that this docket be closed.

Based upon the foregoing and the record herein, the Chairman finds good cause to allow withdrawal of the application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity and registration, to cancel the registration and the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to the Applicant, and to close this docket.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
