BY THE CHAIRMAN: On June 15, 2015, the Commission issued an Order in this proceeding giving notice of its intent to dismiss without prejudice pursuant to Commission Rule R8-64(c)(2) the application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) filed by Carolina Alternative Energy, LLC, in Docket No. SP-1824, Sub 0. Commission Rule R8-64(c)(2) states:

If the applicant does not file the affidavit of publication and certificate of service within twelve months of the Commission's publication order, the Commission will automatically dismiss the application.

The Commission issued an Order Requiring Publication of Notice in Docket No. SP-1824, Sub 0 on May 10, 2012, more than twelve months ago. As of the date of this Order the applicant has not filed the affidavit of publication and certificate of service as required by the May 10, 2012 Order and Commission Rule R8-64(c)(1). The Chairman, therefore, finds and concludes that it is appropriate to dismiss this CPCN application and to close Docket No. SP-1824, Sub 0 without prejudice to the right of Carolina Alternative Energy, LLC, to subsequently file a new CPCN application for this facility.

## IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That the application for a CPCN filed by Carolina Alternative Energy, LLC, in Docket No. SP-1824, Sub 0 shall be dismissed without prejudice and that docket closed; and
- 2. That the Chief Clerk shall serve this Order on Carolina Alternative Energy, LLC, via certified mail, return receipt requested.
