BY THE CHAIRMAN: On July 30, 2013, in Docket No. SP-751, Sub 8, the Commission issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN), to SunEnergy 1, LLC (SunEnergy 1), for construction of a 20-MW solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located on Edwards Fork Road in Scotland Neck, Halifax County, North Carolina.

On November 21, 2013, SunEnergy 1 and Dogwood Solar, LLC (Dogwood), filed a notification with the Commission in Docket Nos. SP-751, Sub 8 and SP-3188, Sub 0 informing the Commission of the plan of SunEnergy 1 and Dogwood to transfer the CPCN for the facility from SunEnergy 1 to Dogwood.

On December 5, 2013, SunEnergy 1 and Dogwood filed a statement with the Commission in Docket Nos. SP-751, Sub 8 and SP-3188, Sub 0 informing the Commission that the transfer of the CPCN was complete, and requesting that the Commission transfer the CPCN for the facility to Dogwood.

Based on the foregoing and the record in these dockets, the Chairman finds good cause to transfer the CPCN for the facility from SunEnergy 1 to Dogwood, issue an amended CPCN to Dogwood, cancel the CPCN issued to SunEnergy 1 and close Docket No. SP-751, Sub 8.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That the application filed by SunEnergy 1, LLC, and Dogwood Solar, LLC to transfer the certificate of public convenience and necessity for construction of a 20-MW photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located on Edwards Fork Road in Scotland Neck, Halifax County, North Carolina, to Dogwood Solar, LLC shall be, and is hereby, approved.

2. That Appendix A shall constitute the amended certificate of public convenience and necessity reflecting the transfer of the certificate to Dogwood Solar, LLC.


3. That the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to SunEnergy 1, LLC in Docket No. SP-751, Sub 8 for this solar photovoltaic facility shall be, and is hereby, cancelled.

4. That the Chief Clerk shall close Docket No. SP-751, Sub 8.
