BY THE CHAIRMAN: On March 18, 2013, in Docket No. SP-2357, Sub 0, the Commission issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN), to DEGS NC Solar, LLC, for construction of a 20-MW solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located at the Warren Field Airport in Washington, Beaufort County, North Carolina.

On November 19, 2013, DEGS NC Solar, LLC, now known as Duke Energy Renewables NC Solar, LLC (DER), and Washington Airport Solar, LLC (Airport Solar), filed a notification with the Commission in Docket Nos. SP-2357, Sub 0 and SP-3177, Sub 0 informing the Commission of the plan of DER and Airport Solar to transfer the CPCN for the facility from DER to Airport Solar. In addition, DER stated that the size of the facility has been changed from 20 MW to 5 MW.

On December 5, 2013, DER and Airport Solar filed a statement with the Commission in Docket Nos. SP-2357, Sub 0 and SP-3177, Sub 0 informing the Commission that the transfer of the CPCN was complete, and requesting that the Commission transfer the CPCN for the facility to Airport Solar.

Based on the foregoing and the record in these dockets, the Chairman finds good cause to transfer the CPCN for the facility from DER to Airport Solar, issue an

amended CPCN to Airport Solar for a 5-MW facility, cancel the CPCN issued to DER and close Docket No. SP-2357, Sub 0.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That the application filed by Duke Energy Renewables NC Solar, LLC, and Washington Airport Solar, LLC to transfer the certificate of public convenience and necessity for construction of a photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located at the Warren Field Airport in Washington, Beaufort County, North Carolina, to Washington Airport Solar, LLC, and to amend the certificate to reflect a capacity of 5 MW, shall be, and is hereby, approved.

2. That Appendix A shall constitute the amended certificate of public convenience and necessity reflecting the transfer of the certificate to Washington Airport Solar, LLC, and the change in capacity of the facility.


3. That the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to DEGS NC Solar, LLC, now known as Duke Energy Renewables NC Solar, LLC, in Docket No. SP-2357, Sub 0 for this solar photovoltaic facility shall be, and is hereby, cancelled.

4. That the Chief Clerk shall close Docket No. SP-2357, Sub 0.


