**Re: PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. Docket No. ER13-_____-000
First Revised Service Agreement No. 3452; Queue No. Y1-020**

Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to section 205 of the Federal Power Act (“FPA”),¹ and part 35 of the regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission” or “FERC”),² PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (“PJM”) submits for filing an executed Wholesale Market Participation Agreement (“WMPA” or “Agreement”) entered into among PJM, Beaver Run Solar Farm, LLC (“Beaver Run Solar”), and Jersey Central Power & Light Company, a FirstEnergy Company (“JCPL”) (“Beaver Run Solar WMPA”), executed on August 8, 2013. PJM is submitting this Agreement for filing because Beaver Run Solar intends to engage in wholesale sales in the PJM markets from a generating facility connected to the JCPL distribution facilities. The Beaver Run Solar WMPA is amending Original Service Agreement No. 3452 to add Capacity

Interconnection Rights (“CIRs”) to the Customer Facility.³ PJM requests an effective date of August 8, 2013 for the Beaver Run Solar WMPA, which is designated as First Revised Service Agreement No. No. 3452⁴ and is attached to this filing. The WMPA will facilitate Beaver Run Solar’s intent to engage in jurisdictional wholesale transactions in the PJM markets, which will originate over JCPL’s non-jurisdictional distribution facilities. In all other respects, this WMPA is the same as it was submitted to the Commission in Docket No. ER13-691-000.

I. Waiver and Effective Date

PJM requests that the Commission grant any and all waivers of the Commission’s rules and regulations that are necessary for acceptance of this filing and the enclosed WMPA. Additionally, PJM requests a waiver of the Commission’s 60-day prior notice requirement to allow an effective date of August 8, 2013, for the Beaver Run Solar WMPA, as set forth in § 1.1 thereof. Waiver is appropriate because the WMPA is being filed within thirty (30) days of its requested effective date. *See Prior Notice and Filing Requirements Under Part II of the Federal Power Act*, 64 FERC ¶ 61,139 at 61,983-84 (1993).
