

New Source Review newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications, May 14, 2015. The following public notices have been published in the newspapers listed below each advertisement. These newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications were published on one of the following dates: May 12, 2015, May 13, 2015, or May 14, 2015. Public notices are generally published every two weeks. The previous publication of public notices was April 30, 2015.

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-3-9-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mr. Barry R. Stephens, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, William R. Snodgrass Tennessee Tower, 312 Rosa L. Parks Avenue, 15th Floor, Nashville, Tennessee 37243 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. Questions concerning a source may be addressed to the assigned Division personnel at the same address or by calling 615-532-0554.

Any individuals with disabilities who wish to participate in these proceedings or to review these filings should contact the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to discuss any auxiliary aids or services needed to facilitate such participation. Such initial contact may be in person, by writing, telephone, or other means, and should be made no less than ten (10) days prior to the hearing, or the date such party intends to review such filings, to allow time to provide such aid or service. The applicant is Energy Transfer Crude Oil Company, LLC with a mailing address of 800 E. Santera Blvd. #400, San Antonio, TX 78258. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 23-0171-02 / 70132) for construction of a 105,000-gallon surge relief tank to be located at 1224 Bonicord Road, Dyersburg, TN 38024. The proposed tank would be part of a crude oil pumping station, and would be used during pipeline maintenance events. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. R. Thompson is the assigned Division person.

For the Dyer County "State Gazette"--publish once on Thursday, May 14, 2015.

The applicant is Pringles Manufacturing Company with a mailing address of 1306 Highway 70 Bypass, Jackson, TN 38301. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 57-0035-43/70192) for construction of a Baking Line at the same address. This proposed operation would consist of a natural gas fired baking oven and associated equipment used to bake snack foods. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. M. Reynolds is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Rogers Group, Inc. - Lynchburg Quarry with a mailing address of 421 Great Circle Road, Nashville, TN 37228. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 64-0010-03/970000) for a portable rock crushing and sizing operation located at 643 Buckeye Loop Road, Lynchburg, Tennessee. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Wet suppression is used for pollution control of particulates. Mr. Thomas Krinov is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Middle Tennessee State University with the mailing address: 1301 East Main Street, Murfreesboro, TN 37132. They seek to obtain air contaminant permit(s) (Division identification number(s): 75-0064-39 / 970193P) for installation of a diesel-fueled engine that drives a 600 kW emergency generator. The facility is located at 1500 Greenland Drive, Murfreesboro, TN 37132. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. R. Benjamin is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Nashville Ready Mix of Lavergne with a mailing address of 605 Cowan Street, Nashville, TN 37207. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 75-0433-01/70212) for addition of a Storage Silo for Cement Supplement with Baghouse Control at 480 Mason Road, Lavergne, TN 37086. This proposed operation would consist of a storage silo and associated equipment used to store cement supplement. A baghouse would be used for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. C. Meek is the assigned Division person.

For the Rutherford County “Daily News Journal”--publish once on Thursday, May 14, 2015.

The applicant is Polestar TN Sevierville (Wagner), LLC with a mailing address of 736 Cherry Street, Chattanooga, TN 37402. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 78-0329-01/70142) for construction of a gasoline dispensing facility (GDF) located at 1185 Dolly Parton Parkway, Sevierville, TN 37862. This operation will consist of underground gasoline storage tanks and above ground dispensing equipment. Stage I pollution control devices will be used with vent valves. There would be physical construction and regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. D. Wright is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) – Cumberland Fossil Plant with a mailing address of 1101 Market Street, Chattanooga, TN 37402-2801. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 81-0011-52/63669) for a Clean Coal Additive facility located at 815 Cumberland City Road, Cumberland City, TN 37050. This operation will consist of two silos and handling operations for fuel additives (urea and magnesium hydroxide) intended to reduce hazardous emissions upon combustion of the fuel. This operation will be controlled by bin vent filters to control particulate emissions. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Mr. Joshua Bartlett is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Super Mart II with a mailing address of 1503 Memorial Blvd, Springfield, Tennessee, 37172. They seek to obtain air contaminant permit(s) (Division identification number(s): 83-0380-01/970026G) for installation of a new gasoline storage tanks at the gasoline dispensing facility. The facility is located on 501 Garnet Court, Gallatin, TN 37066. The requested operation is for the approval to emit regulated air pollutants. Mr. Jim A. Attar is the assigned Division person.

They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 86-0002-08/70078) for modification of the existing Enriched Uranium Processing Operations located at 1205 Banner Hill Road, Erwin, TN 37650-0337. These existing operations are made-up of equipment used to process, recover, and blend various uranium materials. The requested modification is to change the allowable raw material inputs and to increase allowable input rates. Wet scrubbers and HEPA filters (which are process controls) are used for pollution control. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air pollutants are emitted by this source. Mr. Moe Baghernejad is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is LoJac Enterprises, Inc. with a mailing address of P.O. Box 387, Hermitage, TN 37076. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 94-0019-02/70250) for construction of a Portable Asphalt Plant located at 800 Downs Boulevard, Franklin, TN 37064. This proposed operation consists of crushed rock and sand stockpiles, a double barrel drum mix, and associated equipment used to produce hot-mix asphalt. The primary fuel will be natural gas with No. 2 diesel fuel as the alternative fuel. A high temperature filter baghouse will be used for pollution control. There will be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Mr. C. Meek is the assigned Division person.

This proposed operation would consist of a storage silo and associated equipment used to store cement supplement. A baghouse would be used for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. C. Meek is the assigned Division person.
