Dear Ms. Osborne:

On July 17, 2019, the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada ("Commission") issued an order approving the application of Nevada Power Company d/b/a NV Energy ("Nevada Power"), under the provisions of the Utility Environmental Protection Act, for a permit to construct a 230/69 kV auto bank and associated facilities at the Bighorn Substation located in Clark County, Nevada (the "Order"). Pursuant to compliance paragraph 5 of the Order, Nevada Power is required to file proof that its request for integrated resource plan approval of the Bighorn Substation project has been approved in Docket No. 19-05003, prior to the Commission issuing the final permit to construct.

On August 30, 2019, the Commission issued an order in Docket No. 19-05003, which granted the stipulation in that docket. As part of the stipulation, the parties recommended Commission approval of the Bighorn Substation project. See Docket No. 19-05003, Stipulation p. 5, paragraph 14.

As a result, Nevada Power is filing this letter pursuant to compliance paragraph 5 in the Order, and respectfully request that the Commission issue a permit to construct the Bighorn Substation project.
