Staff Recommended License Conditions



- 1 A. After reading the testimony of the Company's witnesses and performing my own  
2 analysis, I recommend that the Commission:
- 3 (1) Grant a CPCN to Kieffer Funk to construct and operate an 11.80 MW solar  
4 generating facility;
- 5 (2) Require the filing of a request for a CPCN amendment with the Commission for any  
6 generation capacity in excess of 11.80 MW;
- 7 (3) Require that the signed Interconnection Agreement executed between Kieffer Funk  
8 and the local utility with which the Project will interconnect (Potomac Edison  
9 Company ("PE")) be filed with the Commission prior to Kiefer Funk's  
10 commencement of construction of any component of its Project;
- 11 (4) Require that Kieffer Funk, its successors and assigns, provide sixty (60) days written  
12 notice to the Commission of any non-wholesale electricity sale to a Maryland retail  
13 electric customer and comply with all regulations regarding such sale including  
14 obtaining any requisite Interconnection Agreement(s) and retail supplier license(s)  
15 prior to delivering electricity into the respective distribution systems of Maryland  
16 electric companies;
- 17 (5) Require that Kieffer Funk, its successors and assigns, provide written notice of any  
18 change in ownership of all, or any portion of the Project, at least thirty (30) days prior  
19 to the closing date of any sale to a third party. The written notice should include, but  
20 not be limited to, identifying the third party, and providing contact information to  
21 receive any Commission inquiries, the proposed effective date of any change in  
22 ownership, and providing documentation that demonstrates the capability of the  
23 prospective owner to operate and maintain the Project to perform in accordance with  
24 any CPCN issued in this proceeding; and
- 25 (6) Adopt any additional conditions proposed by the other State agencies having  
26 jurisdiction in this proceeding.
