Our office represents New Bremen Solar, LLC (“the Applicant”) which will be seeking a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (“Certificate”), under Article 10 of the Public Service Law, to construct the New Bremen Solar Project (“the Project”) – an approximately 100-MWac solar powered electric generating facility proposed to be located in the Town of New Bremen, County of Lewis, New York.

Under 16 NYCRR § 1000.4, a prospective Certificate Applicant is required to submit a proposed Public Involvement Program (“PIP”) plan for review by the Department of Public Service (“DPS”) staff at least 150 days prior to the filing of a Preliminary Scoping Statement. Accordingly, the Applicant hereby submits, for DPS Staff’s review and comment, a proposed PIP plan, Figures depicting the Project Area and Study Area, Exhibits identifying the stakeholders for this Project, Goals and Objectives of Stakeholder Consultation, and a sample PIP tracking log.
