NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL APPROVAL
TO CONSTRUCT A UTILITY FACILITY

On December 21, 2020, Holeshot Energy Storage LLC (“Holeshot Energy”) filed with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (“Commission”) a notice, designated as Docket No. 20-12021 (“Notice”), under the provisions of the Utility Environmental Protection Act, of an application to a federal agency for approval to construct the Holeshot Storage Project consisting of a 100 megawatt/400 megawatt-hour battery energy storage system, a 138 kilovolt transmission line, and associated facilities to be located in Clark County, Nevada.

This Notice serves only to notify the public that the Commission has received the above-referenced filing. It is the responsibility of interested persons to review the filing and monitor the proceedings to determine their desired levels of involvement based on how this matter may affect their unique situations. The details provided within this Notice are for informational purposes only and are not meant to be an all-inclusive overview of the filing.

Holeshot Energy filed the Notice pursuant to the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) and the Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”) Chapters 703 and 704, including, but not limited to, NRS 704.870(2) and NAC 703.421.
